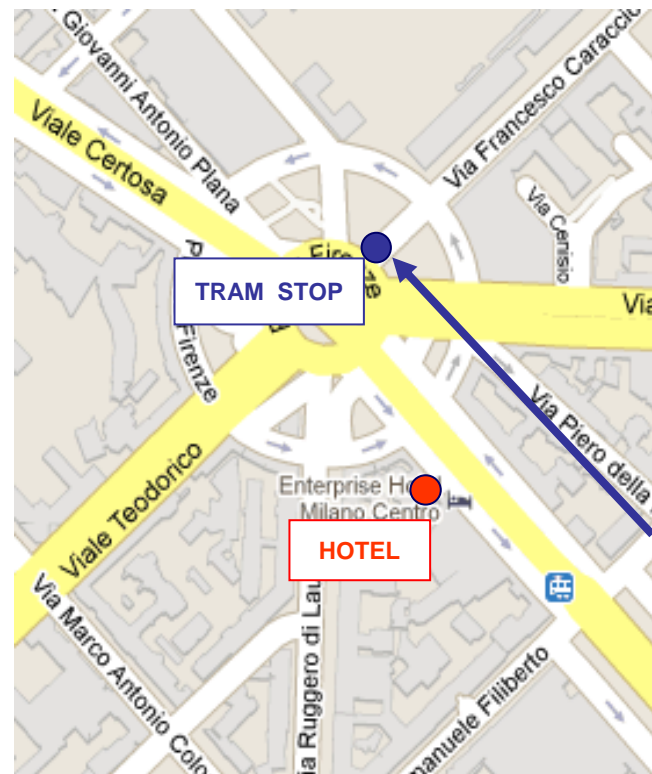


How to reach the Conference:

The Organization:
